

Locker Terminology

What is a Locker?

A Locker is a single unit made up of one or many doors. This image has one door, however a single locker can have up to twelve doors.



What is a Tier?


A single locker with four doors is referred to as a '4 Tier or 4 Door Locker'.



What is a Bank?

The number of lockers in a row is referred to as either a 'Bank' of lockers or a 'Run' of lockers. This example shows 3x4 Tier Lockers containing a total of 12 doors.

This would be referred to as a 'Run of 3x4 Tier Lockers'.
